

Phrase 2: Rock from side to side to the beat back to back. On the word 'over' both children turn back through the arch made by the joined arms to face each other.




Children sit in a circle and sing the song while 'Johnny' walks around the outside. At the end of the song Johnny taps a child and they race to be first back to the space in the circle.
