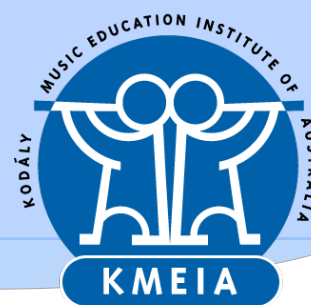

Australian Kodály Certificate Course 2015
Primary 2 and Secondary 2 Scholarships



General Information

The Australian Kodály Certificate is the only Australian fully accredited and nationally recognised program of teacher training in the Kodály approach. It was established some 20 years ago and during this time over 150 teachers have successfully completed the requirements. The certificate is normally completed over three years of part time study. In 2015, the Western Australian Branch will offer Level 2 of the 10-day course in the Primary or Secondary specialisations.



WA Branch Level 2 AKC Scholarship

KMEIA WA recognises that undertaking the AKC teacher training courses is a significant financial undertaking for participants. Western Australian members of KMEIA who will undertake the "Primary 2 or Secondary 2" stream of the 2015 KMEIA WA AKC Training Course for assessment are eligible to apply for this scholarship. A scholarship selection panel led by the President of KMEIA WA will award **up to two scholarships to the value of half of the super-early-bird course tuition fee.**

The successful applicants will be required to write a report for the *Branch Newsletter* or other means as negotiated with the KMEIA WA Committee.

Selection Criteria

Applicants will:

- be a current financial member of KMEIA and reside in the state of Western Australia;
- have successfully completed the Level 1 stream and be enrolling in the *Primary 2* or *Secondary 2* stream as a full-time participant;
- demonstrate interest, experience and commitment to developing further their understanding of Kodály philosophy;
- outline how their teaching practice will benefit as a result of attending the AKC Course as a scholarship recipient.

Application Procedure

Applicants should:

- be prepared to provide information about their qualifications, professional experience and contact details in the online form;
- provide contact teachers for one professional referee;
- prepare responses that address the selection criteria.
